

Washington County BIRTH TO THREE PROGRAM

- Provides services to children who have developmental delays or developmental disabilities for children from *birth until their third birthday* and is a state/federally mandated program.
- Range of services which may include special education and therapies, information and referral service coordination and other support services
- Services are provided in the home or community
- Parents may share in the cost of the services

WHO TO REFER FOR EVALUATIONS

Children, aged birth to three, who are suspected of having developmental delays in any of the following areas: communication, sensory needs, cognitive, social, self – help, vision/hearing, and motor areas.

ELIGIBILITY FOR SERVICES

- A 25% delay in one or more areas of development
 - Social
 - Cognitive
 - Speech/language
 - Self-help
 - Vision/hearing
 - motor
- A diagnosed condition with a high probability of resulting in a developmental delay

REFERRALS

- Anyone can refer a child for evaluation
- Parents should be aware referral is made
