## **SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS**

Public schools belong to all the people, are supported by the people, and are designed to carry out the wishes of the people for the education of children, youth and adults. The Board should conduct its business in open session except as authorized under open meetings law exemptions, and endeavor by every possible means to inform the public concerning the schools.

It shall be the policy of the School Board that the following guidelines are observed:

1. Public notice of Board meetings shall be given in accordance with State law and established procedures.
2. Regular meetings of the Board shall be determined at the Board organizational meeting which must be held on or within 30 days after the fourth Monday in April.
3. In order to change the regular meeting date and time, a majority of the Board must agree.
