EXECUTIVE SESSIONS

All Board meetings shall be open to the public except that executive sessions may be held for reasons permitted by state law, including but not limited to the following purposes: to consider expulsion, suspension or disciplinary action in connection with any student; to consider the employment or dismissal of a public officer or employee; and to hear complaints or charges brought against a public officer or employee.

Whenever an executive session is held, the Board shall reconvene in public meeting for the purpose of taking final action on the matter if so stated on the agenda.
