SAFE AND HEALTHFUL FACILITIES

It shall be the policy of the School District of Hartford Joint No. 1 to take every reasonable precaution to establish and maintain safe and healthful facilities for the benefit of the students, employees, visitors and all others having business with the District.

The District shall comply with all regulations, state codes and orders of the Department of Commerce, the Department of Health and Family Services and all applicable local safety and health codes and regulations.

It shall be the responsibility of the District Administrator to carry out this policy.

In order to have a comprehensive and long-range program which shall meet the needs of the school and community, the following procedures shall be followed:

1. A school safety plan shall be developed and in effect in each District school to provide as safe an environment as possible for students, employees and citizens while they are present on school premises or participating in school-sponsored activities.
2. The District will utilize an outside environmental agency with a high degree of safety expertise, who will give on-site assistance in the recognition of the various hazard categories, OSHA codes, safety curriculum and follow-up evaluations.
3. All District property will be kept in such a manner as to promote safe and healthful conditions.
4. The District Administrator or his designee will establish an annual building maintenance schedule.
5. Safety is the responsibility of all students, teachers and other employees of the District. Safety instruction shall be a part of the curriculum.
