STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

1. All K-8 public and private school students living outside the city limits and within the boundaries of the School District of Hartford Joint No. 1 shall be transported to and from school. When required, the Board of Education will enter into a private contract with parents to transport their children. All students residing within identified hazardous transportation areas will be transported to and from their assigned school.
2. The location and extent of school bus routes and the location of bus stops shall be determined by the bus contractor and District Administrator or transportation director and formally approved by the Board of Education. It shall be the policy of the Board of Education that no bus shall be required to drive off any public thoroughfare to pick up students.
3. Rules for student bus discipline shall be established by the District Administrator and approved by the Board of Education.
4. Responsibilities of the bus drivers shall be established by the District Administrator in cooperation with the bus contractor and approved by the Board of Education.
