CHILDREN AT RISK PROGRAMS

The Board shall establish programs to serve children in the District who are identified at risk. "Children At Risk" include students who are one or more years behind their age group in the basic skill levels.

All programs developed for children at risk shall be designed to improve and expand educational opportunities for these children on an individualized basis through a variety of means (e.g., remedial instruction) and encourage parental involvement.

Students shall be identified and referred to these programs in accordance with State regulations and guidelines established by the Administration
