**ADMISSION OF NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS
(OTHER THAN OPEN ENROLLMENT STUDENTS)**

Students who move outside of the District's boundaries during the school year may finish the year at the school he or she was attending. However, the parent/guardian must apply under open enrollment during the application period for the child to continue to attend the District the following school year

Parents of students with legal residence outside the boundaries of the School District of Hartford Joint #1 may request permission from the School Board to allow their children to attend school in the District.

If permission is granted, the tuition cost will be based on the per pupil cost formula established by the Department of Public Instruction.

Parents are responsible for the payment of the tuition fee. If a student enrolls in the first semester of the school year, one-half of the fee would be paid upon enrollment and the remaining half on the first day of the second semester. If a student enrolls during the second semester, the parent/guardian is responsible to pay the entire fee upon enrollment.

Upon approval of the District Administrator or designee, if space is available a non-resident student may be allowed to attend the summer school program for the appropriate tuition cost.
