GUIDELINES FOR DEALING WITH STUDENTS OF DIVORCED/SEPARATED PARENTS

All schools in the District shall routinely mail materials given to custodial parents to the non-custodial parent when the non-custodial parent requests such mailings and provides current demographic information. These routine mailings shall include summer mailings, parent newsletters, parent-teacher conference information and report cards.

Non-custodial parents may also receive, upon request:

1. Student progress reports
2. Behavioral record information
3. Attendance letters
4. EEN communication
5. Parent-Teacher Organization events
6. Parent surveys
7. Medical forms

Non-custodial parents may make specific requests for and receive copies of other materials that would be made available to the custodial parents.

At the beginning of each school year, or upon enrollment of a student in the School District of Hartford Joint No. 1, custodial parents shall be asked to provide information regarding the status of the non-custodial parent.
