## **BOARD-COMMUNITY RELATIONS**

Public education today must have the complete understanding of the community it serves. Every possible means of attaining this understanding must be developed by the School District.

The School Board and/or the District Administrator shall, as the need arises, call public meetings for the purpose of discussing problems pertinent to the school program in the District. Special effort shall be exerted in such meetings to solicit attendance from a cross-section of the community.

To further facilitate communication between the Board and its constituents, the Board plans to annually encourage each school staff, each parent/teacher organization and other interested organizations to appoint representatives to attend all Board meetings and share the viewpoint of their group on school-related issues.
