Judy Ashby requested \$135 to pay for food and refreshments for the fourth grade Book It Pizza party, thrown for students who successfully participate in the program. Amy Gauthier made a motion to accept. Nicole Rhode seconded. The motion was voted on and it carried.

d. Motivational Plaques

Judy Ashby requested \$122.40 to purchase motivational plaques for the fourth grade quarterly awards. Nicole Rhode made a motion to accept. Stacy Brzozowski seconded. The motion was voted on and it carried.

e. B.O.B. Trophies

Judy Ashby requested \$205 to purchase trophies and ribbons for the top Battle of the Books teams. Angela Raffensperger made a motion to accept. Stacy Brzozowski seconded. The motion was voted on and it carried.

f. Book it Pizza Party – First grade

Gina Klink requested \$170 to pay for the First grade Book It Pizza party, thrown for first graders who participated in the program 5 out of 6 months. Angela Raffensperger made a motion to accept. Judy Ashby seconded. The motion was voted on and it carried.

g. Teacher Appreciation

Stacy Brzozowski requested \$200 to spend on sub sandwiches for Teacher Appreciation Day. Kristin Blankenburg made a motion to accept. Ides Andrews seconded. The motion was voted on and it carried.

6. OLD BUSINESS

a. Book Fair

Mia Justman reported that there were approximately \$990 in cash profits from the Spring book fair. Approximately \$450 worth of books were provided to Mrs. Hedrick to be used for summer reading needs. All Rossman and 4K students were given a \$5 gift certificate to use at the book fair. Holding the book fair prior to and following the Pro Kids show worked well.

b. Parent Night – Officer Rasmussen

Officer Rasmussen information/family nights will continue next year thanks to Officer Rasmussen's dedication to the community. There was discussion of finding ways to better partner with Lincoln in order to bring larger numbers to the meetings.

c. Open PTO positions

Nominations to the two open co-chair positions (Gina Klink and Pam Christnovich) and the open secretary position (Mia Justman) will be made at the May meeting.

d. Pro Kids Show

There was discussion of the merits of the show and plans to bring the show back. The PTO will look at renewing the program once a contract arrives.

7. NEW BUSINESS

a. Teacher Appreciation

Teacher Appreciation will take place on May 4th. After some discussion, it was agreed that sub sandwiches worked very well and were appreciated by teachers and staff. Stacy Brzozowski will coordinate and send out info.

b. Rob Surette
